- <u>HB 50</u> Passing stopped school buses; mailing of summons.
- <u>HB 243</u> Passing stopped school buses; mailing of summons.
- <u>HB 341</u> Passing stopped school bus; video-monitoring system.
- <u>HB 915</u> Passing stopped school buses; mailing of summons.
- <u>SB 16</u> Passing stopped school buses; mailing of summons.
- <u>SB 74</u> Passing stopped school buses; mailing of summons.
- <u>HB 93</u> School calendar; local school boards responsible.
- <u>HB 571</u> School calendar; local school boards responsible.
- <u>HB 753</u> School calendar; local school boards responsible.
- <u>HB 788</u> School calendar; local school boards responsible.
- <u>SB 340</u> School calendar; local school boards responsible.
- <u>HB 967</u> School term; waiver of length of school term, early course mastery.

Proposed Legislation Failed (Tabled, Stricken, or Passed-by indefinitely)



- <u>HB 306</u> School buses; display of advertising material on sides and rear.
- <u>HB 73</u> Driving while texting; fines.
- <u>SB 730</u> Driving while texting; involuntary manslaughter, maiming, etc., of another, penalties.
- <u>SB 778</u> Use of handheld personal communications devices while driving; penalty.
- <u>HB 265</u> Charter schools, public; amount appropriated to local school boards.
- <u>HB 565</u> Charter schools, public; changes to provisions for establishment and operation.
- <u>SB 275</u> Local school boards; transportation agreements with nonpublic schools.
- <u>HB 853</u> Traffic lights; use of photo-monitoring systems.

- <u>SB 390</u> Temporary visitor's driver's licenses; DMV may issue.
- <u>HB 74</u> Drug offenses, misdemeanor; expungement of records.
- <u>HB 997</u> Marijuana; decriminalization of simple marijuana possession.
- <u>HB 1041</u> Marijuana offenses; driver's license forfeiture.
- <u>HB 1074</u> Marijuana; decriminalization of simple possession.
- <u>HJ 137</u> Driver's license; suspension upon conviction of marijuana offense.
- <u>SB 104</u> Marijuana; decriminalization of simple possession, reduces penalties for distribution.
- <u>HB 850</u> DMV; removes \$5 service charge imposed and collected for in-person transactions.
- <u>SB 613</u> Driver's license; marijuana possession.

Proposed Legislation Failed (Tabled, Stricken, or Passed-by indefinitely)



- <u>SJ 94</u> Driver's license; suspension upon conviction of marijuana offense.
- <u>HB 850</u> DMV; removes \$5 service charge imposed and collected for in-person transactions.
- <u>SB 540</u> Early childhood education; all school divisions to provide for certain children.
- <u>SB 321</u> Public schools; kindergarten instructional time.
